

## **Environmental Fee**

*(Climate Crisis Resilience Fee)*

As of January 1, 2024, all tourist accommodations in Greece are required to implement a new environmental fee defined as the Climate Crisis Resilience Fee. This fee was established under Article 30 of Law 5073/2023 and replaces the previous Accommodation Tax.

The fee is to be paid by guests staying in furnished rooms/apartments (rooms to let), and villas over 80 m<sup>2</sup>. Accommodations are responsible for collecting this fee from guests and remitting it directly to the tax authorities.

The Climate Crisis Resilience Fee is charged per room, per night and must be collected from the guests upon check-out. The specific amount of the fee varies based on the type of lodging and the period of stay, as detailed below:
